## **Biggest Barrier: Implementation**

- Challenge: Overcoming the "checkbox mentality"
- Solution: Shifted focus from offering videos to showing videos
  - Provide detailed feedback to facilities:
    - Monthly summary reports with % videos <u>shown</u> by individual facility
    - Case-level reports of long-stay patients with video ever shown: Y/N
- NH partners are totally on-board → Challenge is implementing within normal operating procedures in the real world

## **Generalizable Lesson Learned**

 Interventions needs to be <u>integrated</u> into standard operating procedures and existing clinical processes

Pragmatic trials must be implemented by health care system staff

- Can't be an add-on to their job; must be part of it –
   embedded in the work-flow
  - Showing videos, enhanced surface cleaning, completing nursing assessment as part of hospitalization decision
