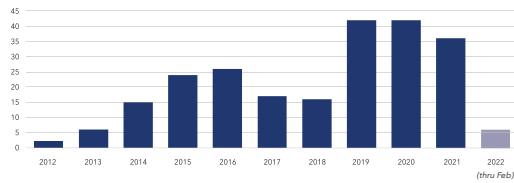

*The weighted relative citation ratio (RCR) is the sum of RCRs for a group of articles. It weights the article count by influence relative to NIH-funded papers. A highly influential set of articles will have a higher weighted RCR than the total number of publications.

*A paper with a relative citation ratio (RCR) of 1.0 has received the same number of citations/year as the median NIH-funded paper in its field, while a paper with an RCR of 2.0 has received twice as many.
