





PCORI

- Independent non-governmental organization
- Goal to help patients, clinicians, purchasers and policy makers make better informed health decisions
- Spearheading CER and pragmatic trials

PCOR Trust Fund 2010-2012: \$210 million

- 2013: ~\$320 million
 - -\$150 million general revenues
 - -\$1/Medicare beneficiary + private plans
- 2014-2019: ~\$650 million/yr
 - -\$150 million general revenues-\$2/beneficiary
- PCORTF not authorized after 2019
